Boat Repairs is on the premises, and many marine mechanics and boat owners get their boat parts through this source. There is also the excellent Breadfruit Tree, a Caribbean-style restaurant at Paradise Point Marina. The surrounding grounds allow you to eat outside, if desired, and even walk up a lookout
